We invite you to nominate someone who contributes to our vibrant art community, and join us at the OmniHonors celebration on February 1, 2024, 5:30-8:00pm at Open Table United Church of Christ, at the corner of Columbus and Jackson Streets in Ottawa.

Nominees will be evaluated on the basis of the breadth and depth of their work and its impact on Starved Rock Country (LaSalle, Bureau, Putnam, Marshall and Grundy counties). A peer panel will review nominations based on the evaluation criteria below.

AWARD CATEGORIES

Individual Artist

Honors an artist whose achievements and commitment to the arts have generated a significant and positive impact on the community over a period of time.

Arts Advocate

Honors an individual whose efforts in advocacy, support, and/or volunteerism in the arts have generated a significant positive impact on the community over a period of time.

Arts Educator

Arts education awards honoring teachers or recognizing schools, school boards and students.

Community Impact Award

Honors a business that recognizes the importance of the arts through financial or in-kind support, use of the arts in the workplace, and/or encouragement of employees to volunteer for the arts, or otherwise serves as an advocate for the arts.

Lifetime Achievement Award

Lifetime achievement awards for artists, arts managers, advocates and others who strengthen the area's culture through significant service.
